

PD-620HB & PD-720HB Software Installation Instructions

Please follow these instructions **exactly** as failure to do so may cause irreversible damage to your radio.

Instructions for 6.2" **PD-620HB**:

- 1) Open the folder called **6_2_and_7_common** and find the file inside called **dvdrom.bin**.
- 2) Copy this file (**dvdrom.bin**) onto an empty USB flash drive. Make sure there is nothing else on the USB drive as this will prevent the installation from starting and it could cause irreversible damage to the radio.
- 3) Power up your radio and wait until the operating system has finished loading.
- 4) Once you are on the radio screen, plug in the USB drive containing the installation file and wait for the software installation to complete. This process is automatic and no action is required on your end. **Caution! The head unit might get permanently damaged if the power is turned off or if the USB is unplugged while the software is being updated.**
- 5) Once the installation has finished, you can unplug the USB. Usually, a welcome screen will give you a clue as when it is okay to unplug the USB drive.
- 6) Next, you need to empty your USB drive deleting all files; or in this case, the one file we just installed. To do this, plug in your USB drive into your computer and delete all contents of the USB drive.
- 7) Now, open the second installation folder called **6.2_MCU_for_Brightness_HDMI**. Inside you will find a file called **dvdrom.Bin**. Copy this file, and this file only, onto your empty USB drive. Safely eject it from your computer.
- 8) Once again, make sure your radio is powered on and the operating system has loaded.
- 9) Insert the USB drive into the radio. Software installation will begin and complete automatically.
- 10) Wait until the radio has powered off and remove the USB drive.

Instructions for 7" PD-720HB:

- 1) Open the folder called **6_2_and_7_common** and find the file inside called **dvdrom.bin**.
