IMPORTANT SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

01 Before you start

Introduction

Congratulations on purchasing the HP-580SB 2.1Ch Audio Sound Bar. Please read this instruction manual to learn about the features and controls of this unit.

Replacing the battery

The remote control uses a pre-installed 3-volt lithium battery. Should the remote control start to work unreliably, replace the battery with a new one of the same type.

Open the battery compartment. Before you take out the battery, please memorize its position. Otherwise, the remote control will not work and may be damaged. Remove the old battery and replace with a new one. Return the battery mounting into position.





IMPORTANT.

- ☑ Do not use or store batteries in direct sunlight or other excessively hot places, such as inside a car or near a heater. This can cause batteries to leak, overheat, explode or catch fire. It can also reduce the life or performance of batteries.
- When disposing of used batteries, please comply with governmental regulations or environmental public instruction's rules that apply in your country/area.

Do...


- □ Use in a well ventilated room.
- Place on a solid, flat, level surface, such as a table, shelf or stereo rack.


Don't...


- ☑ Use in a place exposed to high temperatures or humidity, including near radiators and other heat-generating appliances.
- ☐ Place on a window sill or a place where the player will be exposed to direct sunlight.
- ✓ Use in an excessively dusty or damp environment.
- ☑ Place directly on top of an amplifier or other component in your stereo system that becomes hot in use.
- Use on a thick rug or carpet, or cover with cloth this may prevent proper cooling of the unit.

Press to turn ON the unit or put it on 'Standby' mode.

2 LCD DISPLAY

3 VOLUME UP

Increase sound volume level.

4 VOLUME DOWN

Decrease sound volume level.

5 SEL (Select)

Select Treble, Bass or Balance adjustment.

6 SOURCE

Select music source.

7 SURROUND

Enable/disable Surround mode.

8 MP3 (AUX-IN)

Insert external audio source using 3.5-mm stereo connector.

9 REMOTE IR SENSOR

10 DVD IN JACKS

11 TV IN JACKS

12 CD IN JACKS

13 SUBWOOFER OUT



Using the remote control


Keep in mind the following when using the remote control.

- Make sure that there are no obstacles between the remote and the remote sensor on the unit.
- The remote has a range of about 6 m (19.7 ft.).
- Remote operation may become unreliable if strong sunlight or fluorescent light is shining on the unit's remote sensor.
- Remote controllers for different devices can interfere with each other. Avoid using remotes for other equipment located close to this unit.
- Replace the batteries when you notice a fall off in the operating range of the remote.



Front panel




04 Basic operation

Your system is ready to use as soon as you plug it in and turn it on. Simply press **STANDBY** to activate your system.

Source control

The system has 4 audio input modes:

- DVD In
- TV In
- CD In
- MP3 (AUX In)



The default mode set to CD In. Press **SOURCE** to select the audio signal input source.

Sound control

Press **VOLUME** +/- to adjust system volume.

Press TREBLE +/- and BASS +/- to adjust music tonality.

Surround control

Press **SURROUND** to listen a virtual surround environment.

Press **SURROUND** again to return to Stereo sound mode.

Press **BALANCE+/-** to adjust the balance of sound to the right or left.

05 Additional information

Troubleshooting guide

If the unit encounters any problem, please check the following first before seeking service.

No power/No display.

• Check that the power cord is connected securely.

No sound.

- Make sure the audio source is turned on, and a music track is selected and playing.
- Volume set at minimum. Increase the volume level.

Sound is too low.

- Increase volume setting of the audio source.
- Volume set at minimum. Increase the volume level.

System does not respond to remote control.

- The batteries in the remote are weak: Put in new ones.
- The distance between the remote and the player is too far: use the remote within its operating range.
- The remote is not pointed at the remote sensor of the player.
- There are obstacles between the remote and the player.
- Unplug the power cable for 1 minute, and then plug it back in. This will reset the system.
